Re: Compliance with the Department of Defense Regulations Supplement Regarding
Specialty Metals and Ball and Roller Bearings

Dear Valued Supplier:

The production of aircraft that meet all of our customers' requirements is essential to the success of Sikorsky Aircraft Corporation (Sikorsky) and our suppliers. As part of this commitment and pursuant to your contract(s) with Sikorsky, we are writing to remind your company of its critical obligation to comply with the various U.S. Government regulations involving domestic content restrictions.

More specifically, your company has agreed to comply with the clauses governing specialty metals and ball and roller bearings, namely, Department of Defense Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) Supplement (DFARS) section DFARS § 252.225-7014 ALT 1, *Preference for Specialty Metals*, and DFARS § 252.225-7016, *Restriction on Acquisition of Ball and Roller Bearings*.

These DFARS clauses incorporate domestic source requirements when the end customer is the U.S. Government. Compliance with the requirements of these clauses at the prime and subcontractor levels is mandatory. Please ensure that your company is complying with the specialty metals and bearings clauses, including the obligation to flow these clauses down to your suppliers.

You are required to immediately advise Sikorsky in writing at matweb@sikorsky.com if you determine at any time that your company or any of its suppliers is not complying with the specialty metals and bearings clauses, or any other DFARS or FAR clauses that have been included in your contracts with Sikorsky.
